Summary of IPS Light enhancements for June 2007

Capturing correct delivery office codes for H (attempted delivery) and I (successfully delivered) events

You can now capture the correct delivery office codes for **H** (attempted delivery) and **I** (successfully delivered) events. An additional parameter has been added to the Record Attempted Delivery (EMH) and Record Final Delivery (EMI) functions which allows you to set the delivery office for the event.
